MCS has vacancies for the following positions:

1. Christian Ministry Staff – Primary Schools, Secondary Schools, Junior College & International Schools

The Christian Ministry Staff (“CMS”) in our Methodist schools does ministry in the school context. CMS are appointed through Bishop’s Office to work in our various Methodist schools according to the needs of all our schools, and may be appointed to different schools from time to time. Assisting the School Chaplain(s) and working closely with the Principal, under the supervision of the Director of Ministry in Schools (“DMS”), the CMS will undertake pastoral care and ministry with students, teachers, school leaders and parents of our Methodist schools.

This will include:-

- oversight of the planning and running of the school chapel program and devotions
- student ministry program and activities
- organizing camps and events during both school term and during holidays
- where applicable, ministry in our Methodist student hostels
- pastoral care and training of students, teachers and parent helpers
- counseling
- developing and implementing curriculum
- building relationship and rapport with the students, teachers, and parents

Requirements

- Mature and growing Christian
- Good interpersonal skills with students and adults, and both willingness and maturity to work in a multi-dimension environment which will include church and school leaders and staff, and other stakeholders
- Theologically trained (strongly preferred) – applicants who are not theologically trained must be prepared to undergo theological training
- Experience working with children and/or youth in church, para-church or school setting
- Enjoy working with children and/or youth (whichever is applicable)
- Ability to reach, teach, connect with and counsel children and/or youth
- Ability to speak to children and/or youth in large groups
- Leadership qualities and team-player
- Proactive and self-starter
- Good organization skills and planning
- Proficient with IT (including internet, email, word processing and presentation software)
- Member of a Methodist Church in Singapore, or a Christian prepared to transfer membership to a Methodist Church in Singapore.
